## Certificate III in Community Services - CHC32015

**Pathway:** If helping people comes naturally and advocating for the most vulnerable people in our community is important to you, this course could lead you to employment in a support role within the community, working with Aboriginal Co-Operatives and some youth work supportive roles.

**Duration:** The course duration is 33 weeks, delivered two days per week.

**Requirements:** There are no minimum education requirements to participate in this course, an enrolment fee is applicable.

**Enrolment fee:** Concession - \$300 + GST  
Non-concession - \$600 + GST

- Respond to client needs
- Communicate and work in health or community services
- Follow safe work practices for direct client care
- Manage personal stresses in the work environment
- Work with diverse people
- Work with clients who are intoxicated
- Increase the safety of individuals at risk of suicide
- Recognise and respond to crisis situations
- Provide first point of contact
- Work with people with mental health issues
- Facilitate the interests and rights of clients
- Promote Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander cultural safety
